- All stock must remain on the showground until 4.30pm unless by prior arrangement with the committee – or Prize Money will be withheld
- Any animal entered in calf and calving before the day of the show may alter its class upon notification to the entry secretary
- All in calf animals must be due before 31.12.19
- Exhibitors in local classes must reside within a 10-mile radius of Bingley Parish Church
- All exhibits shall be at the Owners risk
- All exhibitors shall be responsible for ensuring that their clothing and footwear are clean prior to leaving the animal areas
