

## **Section C – Goats**

### **Information / Rules**

- CPH 49/528/8002
- The goat classes are to be held under the Rules, Regulations and Recognition of the British Goat Society, 42 Manse Way, Swanley, Kent BR8 8DD. All exhibits must be registered with the BGS as in the name of the exhibitor, the registered name, number and earmark being quoted on the entry form and the kidding date for goats in milk. All goats in milk must have been kidded or aborted a minimum of 30 days previous to the date of show.
- All milking goats must be stripped out under the official stewards by 6.30pm on Friday evening. First inspection will take place at 7.00am on Saturday and judging will commence at 9.30am. The evening milking must be finished by 6.30pm on Saturday. Milking buckets must be on the table and ready for inspection by 5pm on the Saturday and any goat for which the bucket is not present will be disqualified. All other goats must be on the showground by 9.00am on Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> July and ALL GOATS MUST REMAIN ON THE SHOW GROUND UNTIL 5.00pm. Entry to the show implies acceptance of this rule.
- Exhibitors' tickets will only be issued when two or more entries are received and will not be issued to exhibitors who will be present on Friday unless requested. PLEASE SEND AN SAE FOR YOUR TICKETS, noting how many required on the envelope.
- Milking competition results will be available by telephone from the Section Secretary on 01706 816044. If you require a photocopy of all the results, please supply the secretary with an SAE.
- Exhibitors bringing branches must please clear these away from their pens before leaving the showground, to facilitate the dismantling of pens.
- ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY A CURRENT WHOLE HERD OR MONITORED HERD CAE TEST CERTIFICATE ON A BGS SUBMISSION FORM. This will be returned if you have enclosed a SAE, otherwise on show day. Separate penning will be provided for negative tested and for monitored goats.
- Exhibitors should undertake not to bring the show any goat which is pregnant or any goat which has kidded or aborted within 30 days of the show.
- Exhibitors are requested NOT to bring to the show ANY goat which has ever had a positive reaction to the CAE test. Exhibitors are also advised that milk produced at shows should not be fed to the goats of any age, as this appears to have been a factor in spread of CAE in the past.
- Exhibitors are reminded that they must comply with current DEFRA cleansing and disinfecting regulations.
- The registered number of any goat, initially entered as RAF, must be submitted to the Chief Steward before the goat competes.
